

BOOK REPORT: CEREAL

Due: Friday, October 23, 2015

Student will decorate a cereal box using illustrations and information related to their reading book.

MATERIAL S

- 1) cereal box
- 2) construction paper
- 3) template paper (Teacher will provide)
- 4) Arts and craft materials (scissors, glue, marker, etc)

DIRECTIONS

- 1) Cover the entire cereal box with construction paper so that the original box is completely covered.
- 2) Front of the box: Decorate the front of the box with a picture/illustration that you feel best explains your book. You must include your book's title on the front of the box.
- 3) Right side of the box: Using the template that your teacher gave you, write about your book's characters and setting. Use complete sentences and be detailed in your explanation.
- 4) Left side of the box: Using the template that your teacher gave you, write a summary that describes the <u>main problem</u> and <u>how the problem was solved</u>. Try to use words that will "grab" the readers' attention and make them want to buy your cereal.
- 5) Back of the box: Design a game that is based on the story of your book. It can be a puzzle, word search, a maze, a crossword puzzle, hidden pictures illustration, or any other fun activity that you might find on the back of a cereal box. Make sure the activity includes information about your book.
- 6) Top of the box: Using the template that your teacher gave you, write your name, your number, the title, author, and the number of pages.

PRESENTATION

(1) Using a 3×5 index card, write your book's summary using sequence words such as, first, second, then, next, finally. You will orally present this information to the class.
