



BOOK REPORT: SUITCASE

Due Date: April 29, 2016

Student will decorate a suitcase template using illustrations and information related to their reading book.

MATERIALS

- (1) 6 Tag templates
- (2) 1 suitcase template

DIRECTIONS for TAGS

First tag: Write the title of your book and name of author/illustrator

Second tag: Write the names of all the main characters

Third tag: Write the problem of the story

Fourth tag: Write the solution of the story

Fifth tag: What was the author's purpose (PIE). Explain. (Ex: The author's purpose was to inform because the author taught me about the life cycle of butterflies.)

Sixth tag: What is a connection you made (text to world, text to self, text to text). Explain.

DIRECTIONS for SUITCASE

(A) Using the shapes inside the suitcase, draw in sequential order the events of your story. There are only 6 shapes, therefore you will only be drawing 6 events of your story from start to end.

(B) Write your name on the suitcase handle.

(C) By either stringing or stapling, attach the 6 tag templates in the order listed above on the suitcase's handle bar (without covering your name).

Make sure to color the background of the suitcase and tags. You may decorate and enhance your project anyway you like.

PRESENTATION

Using your pictures that you drew on your suitcase, you will present an oral presentation explaining each illustration.
