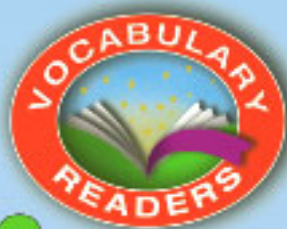

to each other's jokes.



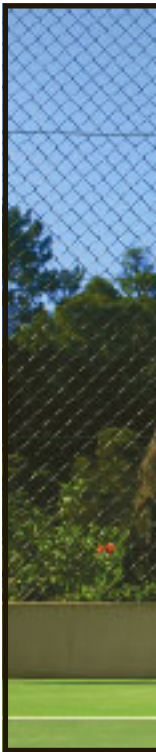
- ▶ Friends play games together and have fun.

You might learn to tie **knots** in a club or make a friendship bracelet.



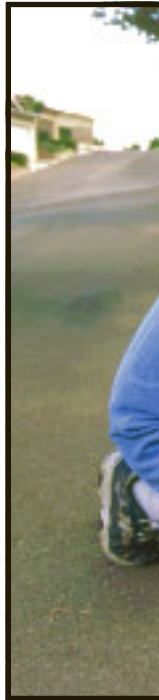
- ▶ Good friends play together. They take turns and share when they are playing games.
