

## BOOK REPORT: SANDWICH Due Date: January 29, 2016

Student will use information from their reading book to create a sandwich using the templates provided by Mrs. An.

## MATERIALS:

(I) Sandwich templates (bread, lettuce, tomato, meat, cheese, onion bread)
(2) String or ring used to hold the sandwich together

## DIRECTIONS

I. Write the book title, author, illustrator and your name on the BREAD top.
2. Write a one-paragraph summary of the book on the LETTUCE.
3. Draw the book's setting on the TOMATO.
4. Describe the main character on the MEAT (use at least 3 character traits).
5. Write about a part of the book that made you happy on the CHEESE.
6. Describe a part of the book that you thought was sweet or sad on the ONION .
7. Tell what you liked or didn't like about the book on the bottom BREAD.
8. Put your sandwich together. Fasten it all together with staples, string or a ring.

## PRESENTATION

Using a $3 \times 5$ index card, write your book's plot. You will verbally present this information to the class.

NOTE: plot is (1) characters (2) setting (3) Beginning, Middle, End (4) Problem and Solution
