

You can buy those too!




Next, you need to get the soil ready for planting. You will need to dig with your shovel.

Corn is a plant that grows tall.


Beans need to climb up something tall.

Squash plants grow big leaves.


The big leaves make shade.

You plant the three sisters in hills. First, you make a small hill of soil. Then you push some corn seeds into the hill.

Next, you plant bean seeds in a circle around the corn hill. Then you plant squash seeds in a circle around the bean circle.



At first, your garden might look plain, but just wait until it starts to grow!

You will need to water it every day. Very soon you will see wrinkled leaves growing.

Then your plants will begin blooming.


And next vegetables will begin

The three sisters help




The three sisters taste great together, too!
